

CHILTERN RIDES 2021

Riders take part at their own risk. No liability shall fall on the organisers, landowners or officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused, and all those entering are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury. If you are booking for other people as well as yourself you must ensure that all those riders have read, understood and agree with these Terms & Conditions.

Health, Safety and Welfare: The Organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards and this includes instructions as to parking.

Children riding unaccompanied must be over 14 or over, and horses/ponies aged 5 and over, to take part. Children aged under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult. If Government restrictions allow, the Ride will be conducted as one group headed by the Field Master of the day. Please pass back to other riders any instruction given to you by the Field Master, eg keep in single file.

Covid-19: Due to current Government Covid-19 guidelines no additional spectators will be permitted. All individuals who continue to be advised by Public Health England to remain in lockdown at home are not to attend the Ride. This includes all individuals who have symptoms of COVID-19 as well as those who live in a household with someone who has symptoms.

No person should attend the Ride, either as a rider or helper on foot, unless they have been symptom-free for the last 7 days, nor been in contact with a member of their household who has those symptoms for the past 14 days (except in a professional capacity as a doctor, nurse or allied health professional).

Riders and helpers must provide their own gloves, masks/face covering and hand sanitizer. Face coverings must be worn in any circumstances when people from different households cannot maintain the 2m social distance guidance.

Social distancing measures must always be adhered to.

ON ARRIVAL, BEFORE YOU GET ON YOUR HORSE please book in, then be mounted and ready to start at the allotted time.

Dress – a guideline is as for a Riding / Pony Club rally, ie dark plain sweat / polo-type shirt, beige or light coloured jods, boots / boots & chaps. However, we will welcome you whatever you wear. Riding hats standard PAS 015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kite mark or equivalent are recommended and back protectors may be worn.

Horse Turnout – Plaiting is not necessary, just clean and tidy as per RC/PC rally. If you know your horse kicks please put a red ribbon on his tail. If your horse is not used to having others around him, ie young, then please put a green ribbon on his tail.
